

# April 13, 2010

Common Council Minutes

Council Chambers, Public Safety Building

Mayor Jim Griffin presided at a Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Stoughton, Dane County, Wisconsin, held in the Council Chambers, Public Safety Building, on Tuesday, April 13, 2010 convening at 7:00 p.m.

City Clerk Alme called the roll and the following Alderpersons were present: Carter, Chenoweth, Christianson, Jenson, Lawrence, McKichan, Odland, Olstad, Scovotti, Swangstu, Tone and Weiss.

Communications: None.

Public Comment Period: None.

Moved by Lawrence, seconded by Scovotti, to approve the following consent agenda items as presented: The minutes of the March 18, 2010 Special Common Council Meeting, March 23, 2010 Common Council Meeting and March 31, 2010 Special Common Council Meeting; the following reports: Commission on Aging, Redevelopment Authority(2), Personnel Committee, Tree Commission, Finance Committee, Stoughton Arts Council, Public Safety Committee, Ad Hoc Stormwater Utility Technical Advisory Committee; and the Public Safety Committee's recommendation to grant a temporary Class "B"/"Class B" retailer's license (picnic license) to the Stoughton Amateur Baseball Club, Inc. to sell fermented malt beverages at Norse Park during Home Talent baseball games. Motion carried unanimously by acclamation.

Aldersperson Weiss presented an ordinance to amend Section 50-3 – Offenses against public health and safety; regarding the smoking ban ordinance and restrictions on the use of laser pointers, for a first reading.

Moved by Carter, seconded by Lawrence, to adopt a resolution declaring intent to exercise special assessment powers under Section 66.0701, Wisconsin Statutes, in the City of Stoughton for the improvement of sidewalk and curb and gutter on various streets in the City of Stoughton and setting May 25, 2010 as the public hearing date to consider these special assessments. Motion carried unanimously on roll call.

Moved by Tone, seconded by Jenson, to approve request for funds from capital outlay for a workstation remodel in the City Hall receptionist office, not to exceed \$4,000. Motion carried unanimously on roll call.

Moved by Tone, seconded by Jenson, to approve the 2008 personal property write-offs, as presented. Motion carried unanimously on roll call.
