This Open House will cover the following street projects:

Main Street Rehab Work – Page Street to Fifth Street – This project is intended to repair and rehabilitate the street and sidewalks in the downtown area. This work is being planned to coincide with the DOT project that will close Main Street from Page Street to Van Buren Street. It entails spot replacement of sidewalk, curb and gutter and concrete pavement sections. Some sidewalk sections will be “raised” similar to the 2019 project on the south side of Main Street between Division Street and Forrest Street. Street closures and local traffic detours will be required to complete the work.

Forrest Street Reconstruction – Main Street to Washington Street – This project includes complete street replacement including curb and gutter. Currently, this segment has variable street widths. We are planning a uniform street width of 39 feet (back to back of curb) which was used when Forrest Street south of Main Street was reconstructed in 2018. This creates a wider terrace from Main Street north to the alley. This project will include new sidewalk and replacement of some existing sidewalk. As part of the project, on-street parking and access near the City Hall entrance will be reconfigured. The City Hall parking lot will also be resurfaced.

DOT USH 51 Pavement Rehab Project – Page Street to Hoel Avenue – The Department of Transportation has planned a pavement rehabilitation project that is scheduled to be completed this year. We will discuss this project and highlight how this project will be coordinated with the downtown projects.
