1. Call to order. Hedstrom called the meeting to order at 7:07 pm.

**2.** Consider approval of the Landmarks Commission meeting minutes of June 22, 2017. Motion by **Swadley** to approve the minutes as presented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by **Mar-Pohl**. Motion carried 5 – 0.

# 3. The City of Stoughton requests a certificate of appropriateness for exterior repairs to the Depot Building, 532 E. Main Street.

Stacey explained the request.

Mar-Pohl stated the mortar has to match the existing mortar in strength and color. A mortar sample should be analyzed. Type O mortar is typical of this era of building. There is a good reference document on the National Parks Service website at nps.gov. It is #2 in the Preservation Briefs – Repointing Mortar Joints in Historic Masonry Buildings (<a href="https://www.nps.gov/tps/how-to-preserve/briefs/2-repoint-mortar-joints.htm#mortarmatch">https://www.nps.gov/tps/how-to-preserve/briefs/2-repoint-mortar-joints.htm#mortarmatch</a>). Center-cut method should be used for mortar repairs. The work should be done by a historic preservation mason.

The Commission will need a description of materials and methods for how the work will be done.

Motion by  $\underline{\text{Mar-Pohl}}$  to Table the request until the applicant provides multiple bids from a historic preservation mason that describes methods and materials planned to be used,  $2^{\text{nd}}$  by  $\underline{\text{Hubing}}$ .

The Commission would like to have Martin Briggs, Building Maintenance Supervisor come to the next meeting to discuss requirements for certificate of appropriateness applications.

Motion carried 5 - 0.

#### 4. Discuss consultant's proposal to write a local landmark nomination.

The Commission discussed finishing the application themselves using the report from Gail Klein for reference. The main issue is getting the application done soon.

Motion by <u>Mar-Pohl</u> to approved the Gail Klein proposal,  $2^{nd}$  by <u>Hubing</u>. Motion carried 5 - 0.
