1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by President Lewis at 5:03PM

2. Approval of committee meeting minutes from September 12, 2019 and October 14, 2019 Motion to approve Sveum, 2nd Lamers, all in favor 4-0

3. Approval Discussion and possible action on time of PFC meetings

It was discussed and decided to have all future meetings scheduled to start at 5:30pm. **Motion to approve Lamers, 2**nd **Sveum, all in favor 4-0**

4. Fire Chief Quarterly Report

Deputy Fire Chief Mark Miller filling in for Chief Wegner. Miller reviewed 3rd Quarter Fire report. Highlighted in the report were the notable calls. Sveum asked for the number of actual fire calls and not calls related to EMS and alarms. There was some discussion about this and Sveum requested that in the future each call be noted as to whether it is an actual fire call. He would like the report to note the total number of actual fire calls each quarter.

Motion to approve the Fire Chief's report Lamers, 2nd Bradford, all in favor 4-0

5. Police Chief Quarterly Report

Police Chief Greg Leck reviewed the highlights from the report. He discussed with the group that there has been an increase of breaking into cars & houses. He stated they have been sending out reminders and information to citizens as well as having the officers remind them. Leck stated he has requested a task force. He stated there had been breakins to 50-70 cars in Dane County in the last year.

Leck discussed "Healthy Minds" coming to the November 5th staff meeting. He stated that other area departments are doing this and it has been very successful. He stated Verona's cost had been \$2000-\$3000. He stated that Noel Crystal, the Police Departments DARE officer is the first in Stoughton Wellness Coalition. There was some discussion regarding the near future promotion of a police officer to sergeant and the recruiting and hiring of a

police officer to replace that position. Leck stated they plan to follow the last process used to hire. It was verbally approved by the PFC.

Leck stated the SET (Special Events Team) would probably be activated to assist in Milwaukee for the DNC (Democratic National Event). He stated this would be mutual aid if the request is made.

Leck stated that Detective Brandon Hill talked to the Rotary about social media and he did a good job.

1. Call to Order

2. Discussion and possible action regarding Sergeant Promotional Process

An expert panel will be used to provide feedback to the PFC. This feedback will be given to the PFC once they have completed their face to face interviews with the candidates. It was requested that the list of candidates given to the PFC be paired down to 6 candidates. It was determined that the Sergeant interviews would take place on December 13th at 1:00 in the Utilities building.
