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This Open House will cover the following street projects:

Nygaard Street (Buckingham Road to Roby Road and intersection at Roby Road) – This project is intended to pulverize the asphalt street and repave the street. It entails spot replacement of sidewalk, curb and gutter and driveway aprons. Street closures and local traffic detours will be required to complete the work.

Roby Road (Kings Lynn Road to Lincoln Avenue) – This project is intended to pulverize the asphalt street and repave the street. It entails spot replacement of sidewalk, curb and gutter and driveway aprons. New sidewalk will be installed on the north side of Roby Road between Sundt Lane and Chapin Lane. Street closures and local traffic detours will be required to complete the work.

Roby Road (Van Buren Street to Johnson Street) - A storm sewer will be installed on the north side of Roby Road between Johnson Street and Van Buren Street to accommodate connection of sump pump discharges. New sidewalk will be installed in this block on the north side of Roby Road along with driveway apron replacement. The street is not being repaved in this project section.

Lincoln Avenue (Roby Road to about Eisenhower Road) – This project is intended to pulverize the asphalt street and repave the street. It entails spot replacement of sidewalk, curb and gutter and driveway aprons. Street closures and local traffic detours will be required to complete the work.

Spot sidewalk replacement – Various properties in the northwest quadrant of the City have been identified as meeting City standards for replacement and will be replaced as part of this project.
