

## BOUNDARIES
























- The district was listed in the National Register of Historic Places(NRHP) in 1982.
- Buildings contributing to the NRHP district are eligible to receive the 20% Federal Rehabilitation
  Tax Credit and the 20% Wisconsin Historic Preservation Tax Credit administered by the National Park Service and State Historic Preservation Office.
- Both tax credit programs follow the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties.

### BENEFITS

Additional benefits include:

- Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation
  Community Development Grant, \$250,000.
- Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation Main Street Bounceback Grant, \$10,000.
- Stoughton Landmark Commission Mini-Grant Program, Total of \$15,000 for several projects.
- In addition to incentive-specific requirements, all work in the district will need to follow the 2021 updated design guidelines.
