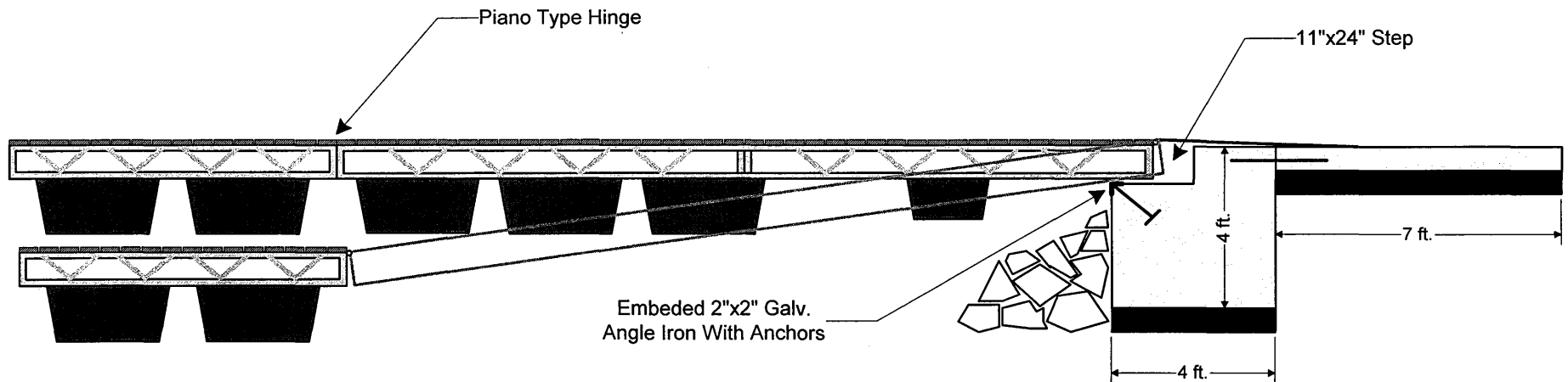
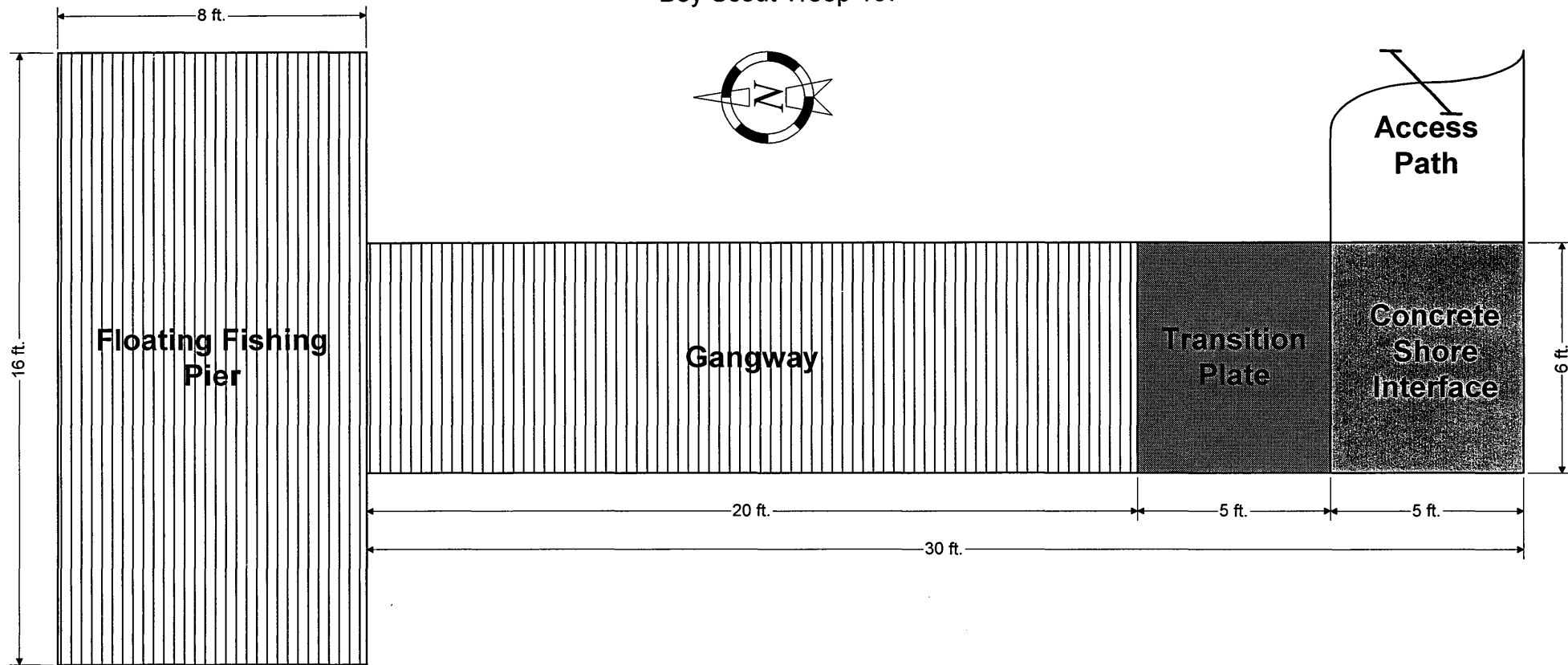

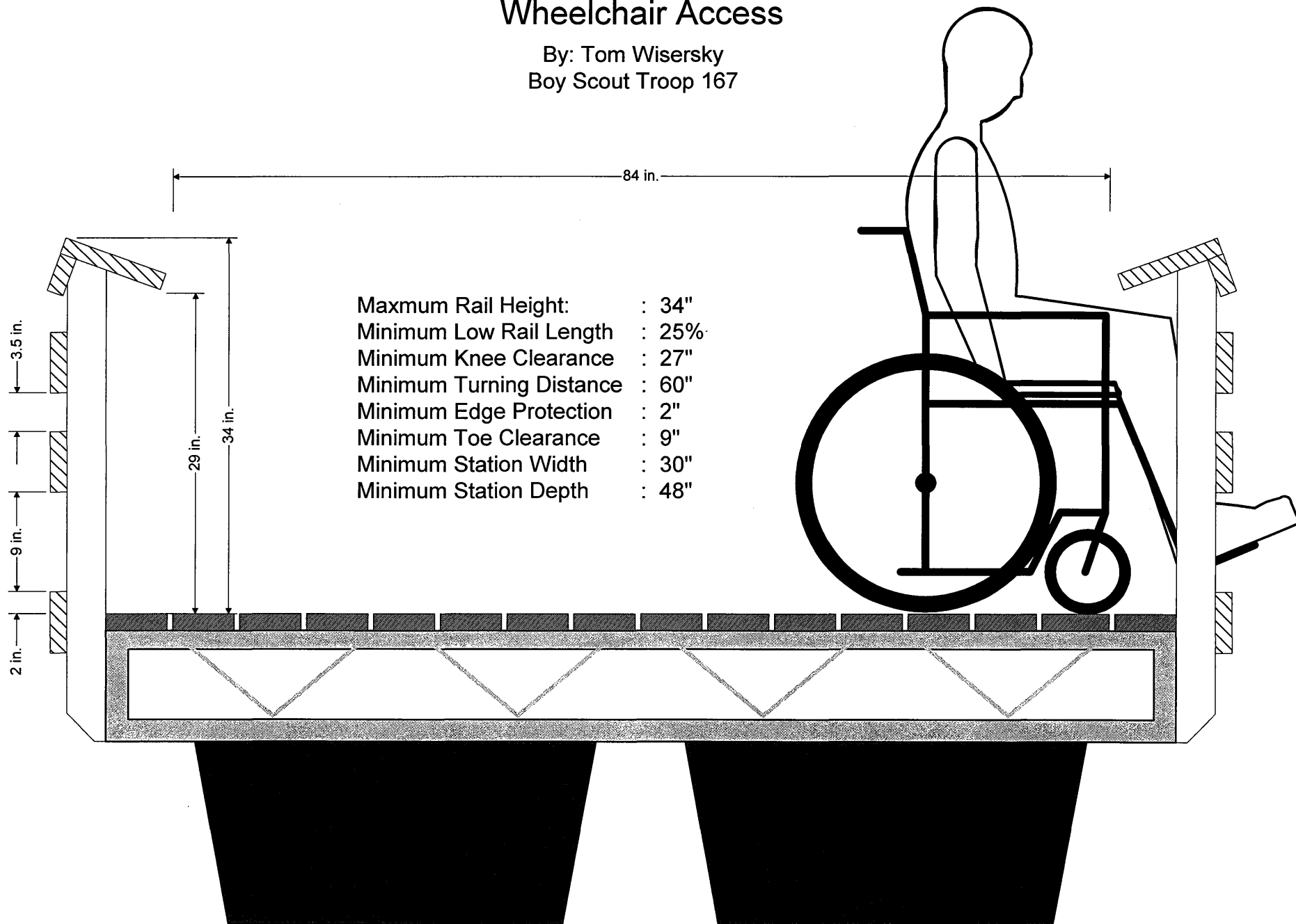

Wheelchair Access

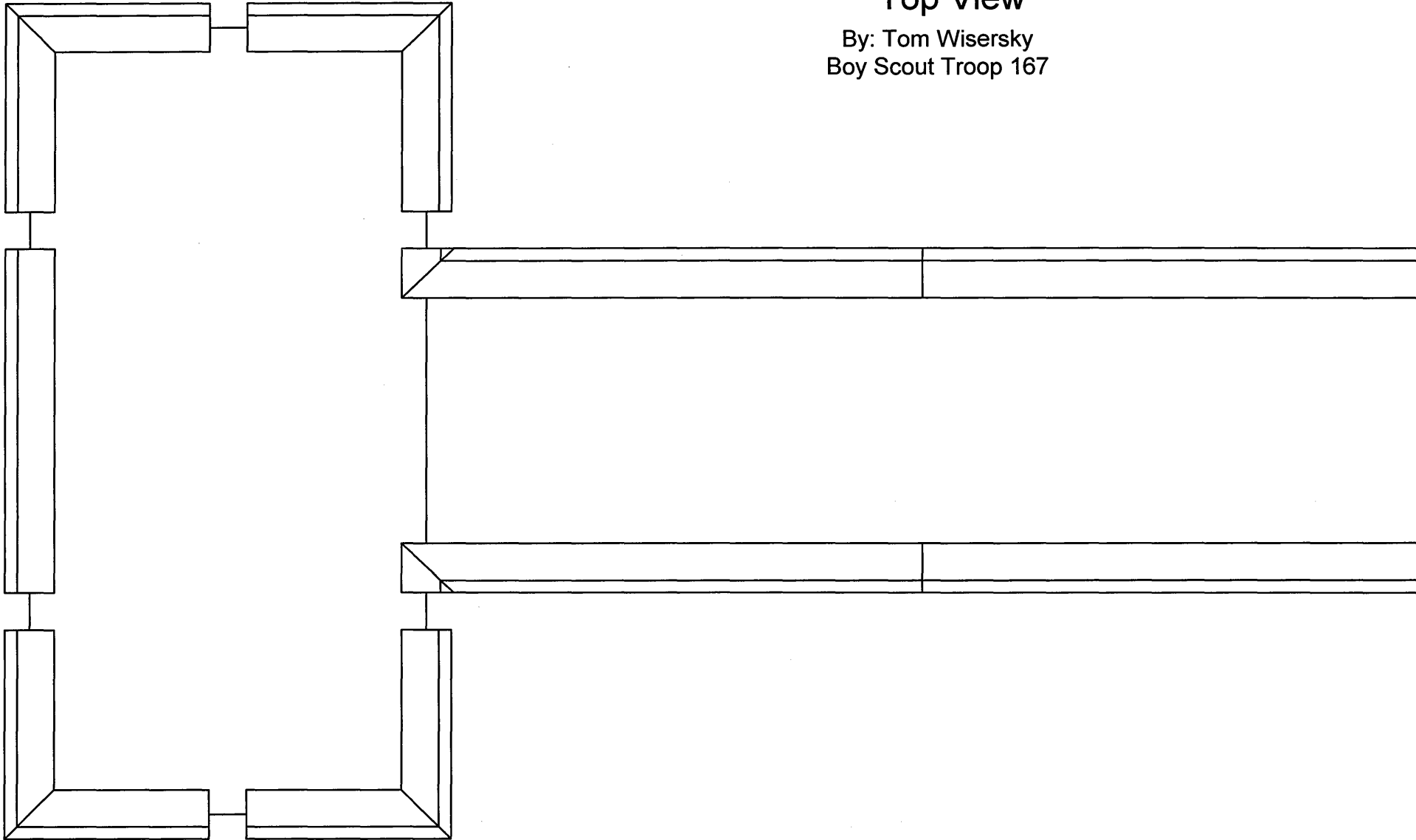

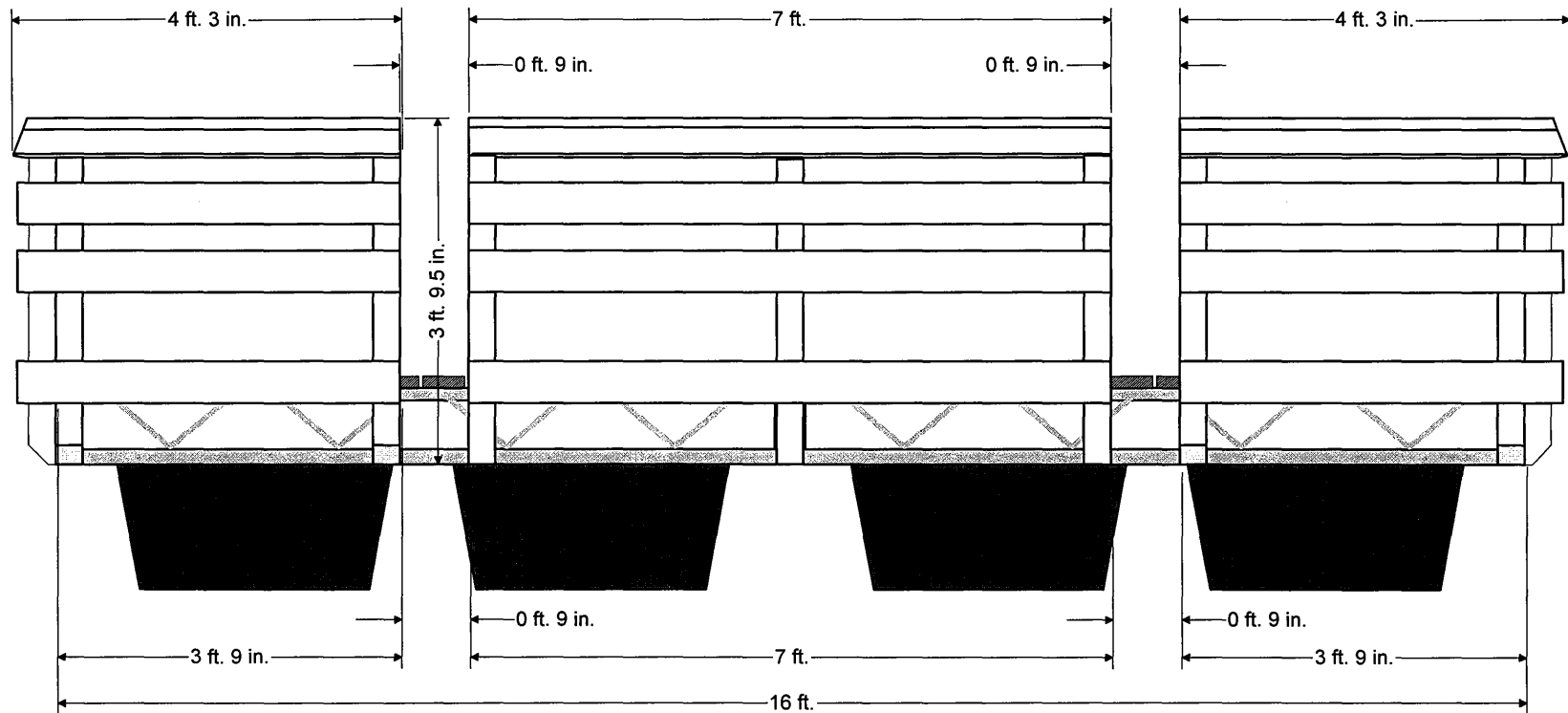

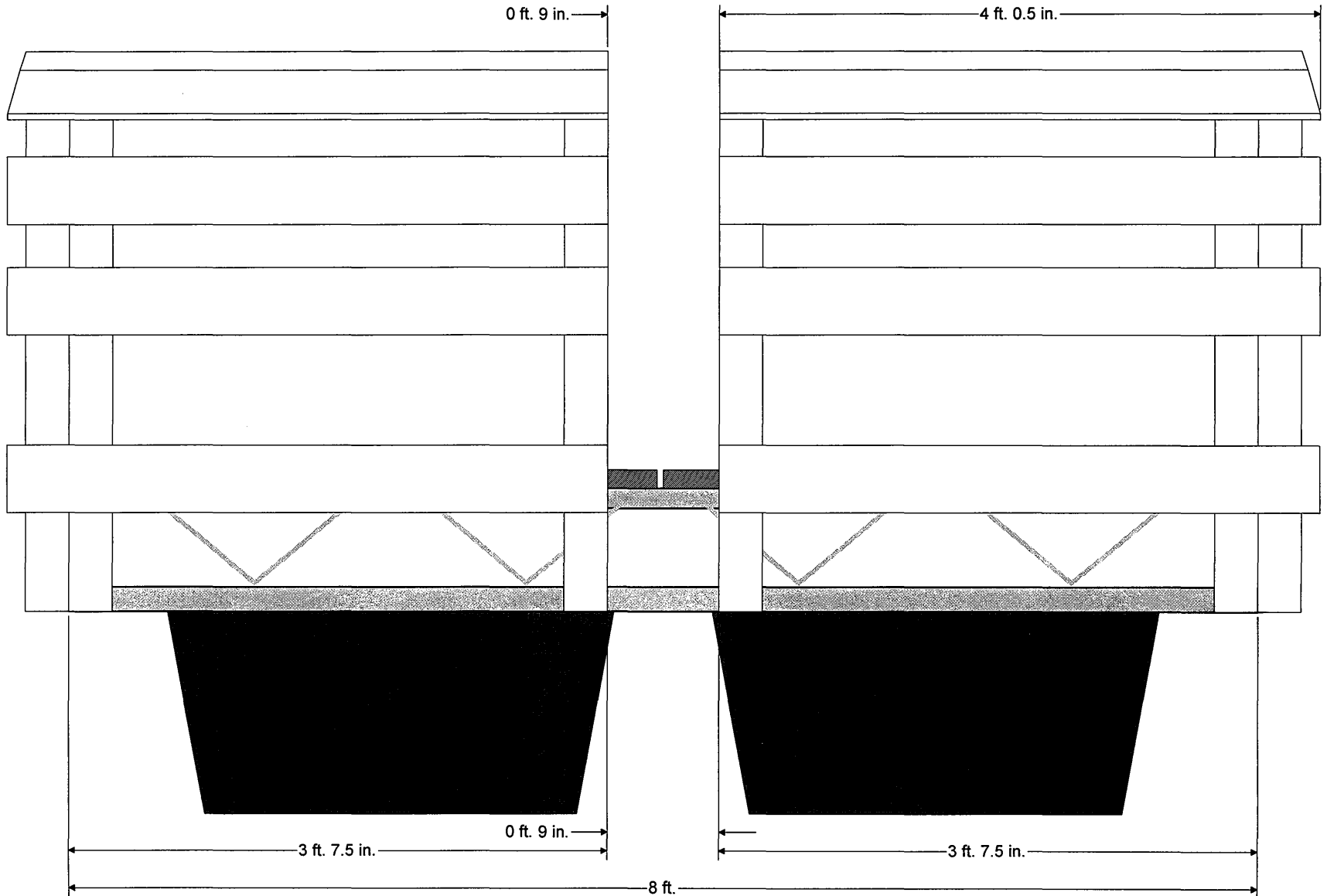

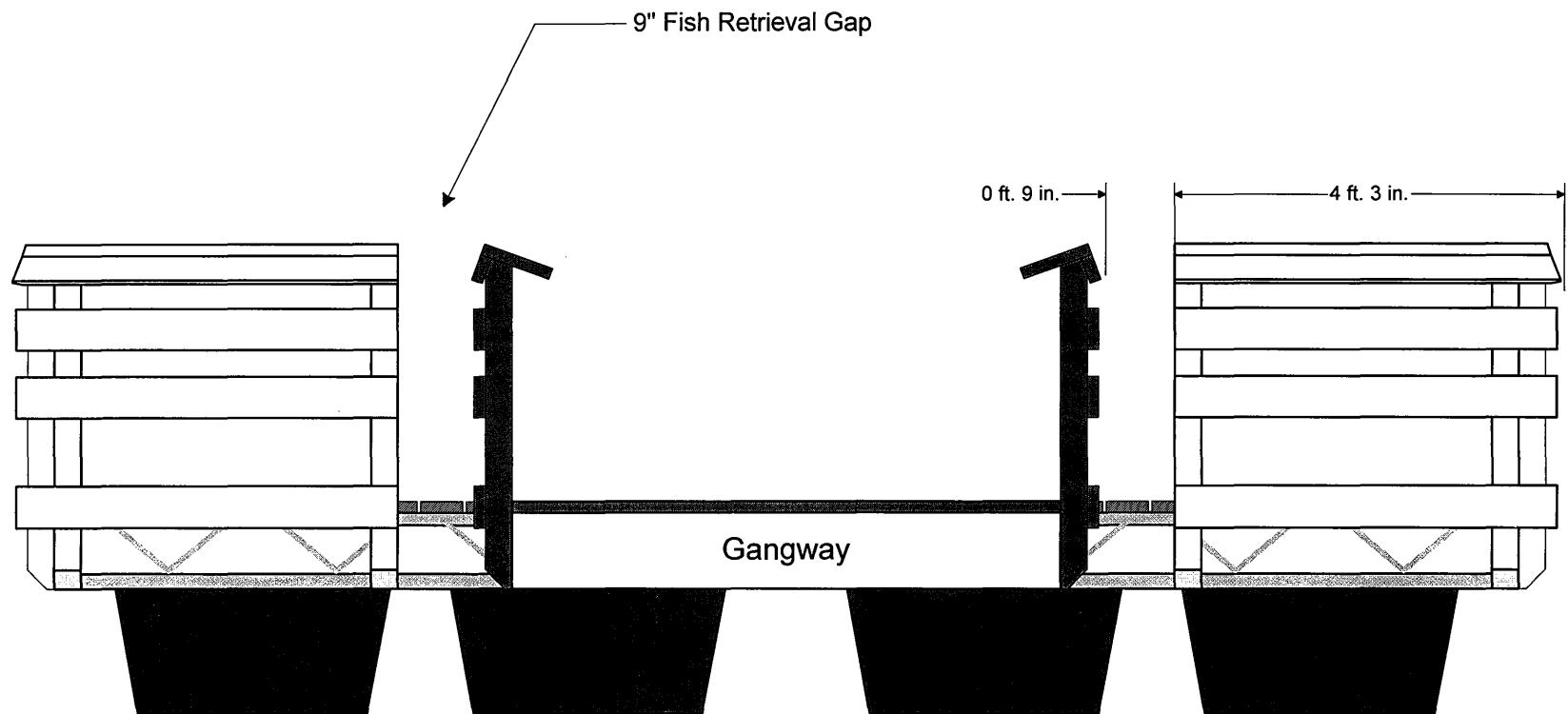

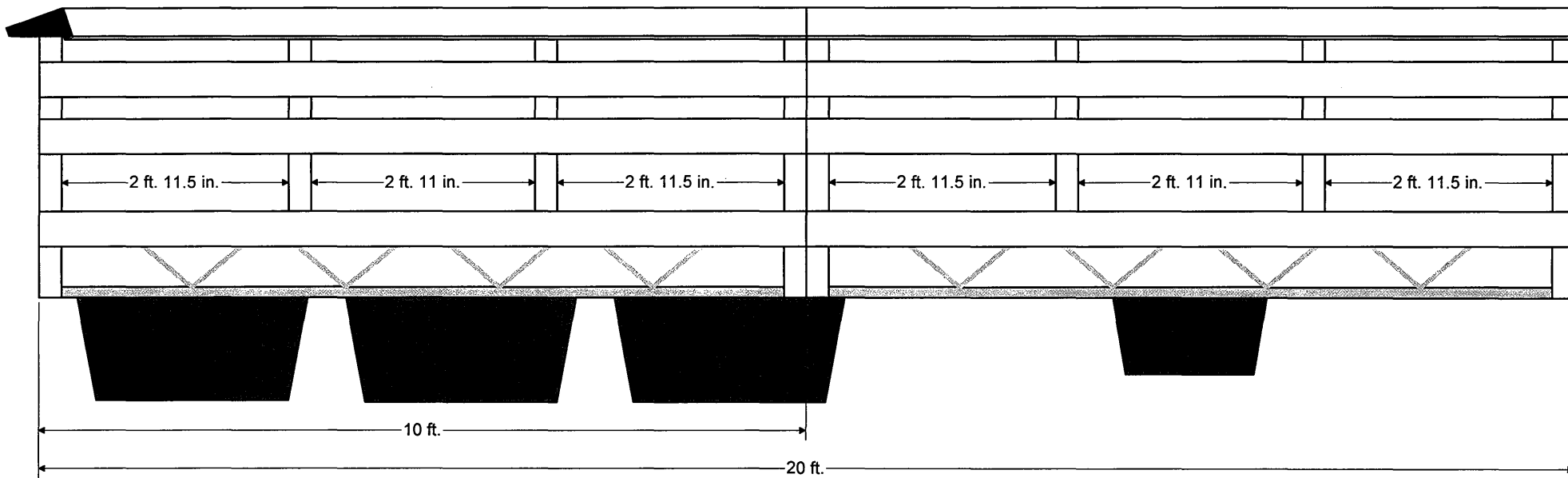
