Resolution Approving a Conditional Use Permit allowing an expansion of the tavern use at Pack R Place, 208 W. Main Street, Stoughton, Wisconsin.

WHEREAS, notice was given that the City of Stoughton Planning Commission is conducting a public hearing at 6:00 p.m. on October 4, 2010 in the Stoughton Council Chambers, 321 S. Fourth Street, at which time any persons wishing, could be heard regarding the above Conditional Use Permit request and the City of Stoughton Planning Commission would at that time make a recommendation to the City of Stoughton Common Council. WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Stoughton, Wisconsin, has review the application for a Conditional Use permit by K & K of Stoughton LLC, owner of Pack R Place Bar, under the provisions of zoning code section 78-905 and has considered the recommendation from the City Planning Commission and has considered all comments from persons speaking at the public hearing.
