

Finance Committee of the City of Stoughton
Tuesday, September 13, 2022 @ 6:00 p.m.

The meeting was a hybrid meeting located in the City Council chambers of the Public Safety Building at 321 S. Fourth St as well as concurrently held via Zoom.

1. **Call to order** – The meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m. by Schumacher.
2. **Establish a quorum** – A quorum was present.

4. **Reports – Baker Tilly US, LLP audited financial statements 2021 and related audit communications** – Andrea Jansen provided a high-level recap of both (a) the Financial Statements and Supplementary Information and (b) Reporting and Insights from 2021 Audit.

12. **Discussion and possible action regarding 2023 addendum to the 2018 Shared Ride Taxi Contract** – Ehlinger inquired about possibly extending the 2018 contract for a sixth year. Motion by Jenson/Thomas to proceed with a possible contract extension for 2023 with the matter coming back to the Finance Committee for final approval before signing. The motion passed 5-0.
