Riverside Park Trail Project



This trail project is a piece for a larger trail that would connect the east to the west on the southern end of the City. This section would connect the current paved section in Mandt Park to the paved section that runs behind Riverside Cemetery and to the possible fishing pier along Riverside Drive.



Construction by Streets and Parks






Top View


North Pier Side View




East/West Pier Side View
