Call to Order

1. Call to order at 5:30 pm.
2. July 11, 2016 Minutes: Approved by Nancy with a second by Jon. Carried.
3. Communications: Sandra received an email that included information on Native Plants for Water Quality and Education. Decided to keep this information for future reference if further planting is needed.

Old Business.

4. Division Street Park Riverbank Restoration Update: Tom stated the delay in pursuing this further was due to strict insurance requirements from the City. There is now an agreement that will be presented tomorrow night at the City Council. Tom discussed the recent \$15,000 grant to help pay for the project as it falls into the required criteria.
5. Amundson Trail Update: Jon stated he has not connected with a person about the Amundson Trail. Tom reported that no easement is needed from Skaalen Home property as they are changing it to City-owned land and an agreement needs to be created. The Stoughton Hospital easement has been approved. Surveys are being completed so bids can be obtained. It is hopeful to start the project this fall.

New Business.

6. Review of Trail Plan: Nancy provided a timetable of the history of the trail system including striping of roads. Discussed how to promote and inform residents of the trail system. Nancy will speak to the Hub about printing an article.
7. On Street/Kings Lynn Bike Lanes: Further discussion at the Council meeting tomorrow night. Nancy will attend the meeting along with Tom. Motion by Nancy with a second by Phil to support restriping of Kings Lynn Road and supporting the long-range trail plan that was instituted in 1997.
8. Future Agenda Items: None.
