Tom,

For the first proposal, Stoughton Utilities (SU) suggests that a street light should be installed on the existing distribution pole (facing the arm and fixture to the West) located East of the parking area. This location would provide adequate lighting for the parking area and would cost approximately \$500.00 to install. The second light fixture SU is proposing would be installed on the West side of the pedestrian pathway and South of the hopscotch area painted on the asphalt. This installation would cost approximately \$2, 800.00 and could be a few hundred dollars less if we could find a clean used pole.

Both these installations would be owned and maintained by the Parks and Recreations Department. The fixture located in the park could be challenging in the winter months if repairs are necessary.
