Call to Order:

She also stated that she thought soon-to-be former Madison Alder Shiva Bidar would be a great facilitator. The committee agreed that May would be a good time frame to initiate this. Ligocki stated that she would like to host more than 1 session. For the next meeting each member to come up with 2-3 inclusive questions that we should ask in light of what has been going on in the US and email them to chair Heili.

Motion by Hirsch, second by Schumacher to approve. Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and possible action regarding public comment policy

Hirsch stated that people should have to be present and read their own comments. . Motion by Hirsch, second by Heili to have public comment be before communications. Motion carried 5-0. Motion by Heili, second by Ligocki to have the policy state 400-word limit in written comments, the council prefers people to present to read their own comments, and include under Section A: a citizen may appear before the council in-person or through electronic communication, or written public comment. Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and possible action regarding remote meeting policy

The committee made no changes to the existing remote meeting policy as it will accommodate hybrid meetings as well as full-virtual meetings.

<u>Discussion and possible action regarding time interval between a committee action and council agenda item</u>

Motion by Ligocki, second by Schumacher to add the following language to the Agenda Item (Placement of) Policy: If a committee has a time-sensitive agenda item, it may be presented to council on an accelerated time frame with prior approval by the council president and mayor and (introductory paragraph) Agenda items are passed by committee and submitted to the mayor and council president customarily by the Thursday before the scheduled council meeting. Motion carried 5-0.

Racial equity; climate change, council goals, committee appointment, policy review.
