  - a. Update of the Mandt Park Riverfront Project: The first draft was shared dated March 4, 2018. There is a 9 foot drop from the first pool to the last. Dan will have cost estimates at the end of this week and apply for a Stewardship Grant in May. Dan has plans to meet with several stakeholder groups.   - b. Virgin Lake Trail boardwalk update: This has not been completed because of the wet weather. They need the boardwalk to be moveable, if needed. Solar kiln-dried wood is being used.

Phil and Bob will do a trial run of putting up the signs with needed tools, etc and correspond to the group with their plan.

- 7. Discussion and possible action of creating a steering committee for the Yahara River Whitewater Park Project. Nancy motioned that the steering committee for the Whitewater Park Project report to Parks and Recreation with a second by Phil.
