Hirsch said she is opposed to limiting council members on standing committees. She added that this could potentially give the mayor too much power in appointing community members. Heili stated that he likes the addition of community members, but not giving up council positions. Mayor Swadley said that he would follow up with Attorney Dregne about logistics. He would like to have a plan in place before the council reorganizes.

<u>Discussion and possible action regarding creating an application process for Mayoral Citizen</u> <u>Appointments</u>

Motion by Hirsch, second by Ligocki to recommend that council approve an application process for mayoral citizen appointments with the following changes on the form: add that applicants may attach their resume and include a field for applicants to write their aldermanic district. Motion carried 5-0.
