The Committee also would like the resolution to include the following: "the City of Stoughton commits the Community Affairs and Council Policy committee to act as a sustainability task force to explore and implement efforts that can move the community toward true sustainability. Motion by Heili, second by Ligocki to approve with those changes. Motion carried 5-0.

<u>Discussion and possible action regarding recognizing the second Monday in October as Indigenous People's Day</u>

Alder Heili explained that many communities have begun to recognize the second Monday in October as Indigenous Peoples Day instead of Columbus Day. He added that he wanted to this respectfully so he is going to work with the Ho-Chunk Nation. He would like to discuss more at the next meeting and will mention it during public comment at the Council meeting.
