Call to Order:

Heili called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.

Motion by Jenson, second by Tilleson to approve the minutes. Motion carried 6-0.

<u>Discussion and possible action regarding holding city meetings virtual, in-person and in hybrid format</u>

Mayor Swadley stated that whatever we do, the public has to have the same access as the members of the council/committees. John Montgomery stated that hybrid must be done in the council chambers and must be done on Zoom—not GoToMeeting. Heili stated that it would be problematic for someone to be the host and also taking minutes. Venegas stated that she likes the hybrid model. Jenson agreed with Venegas but would like the rules codified in the council rules. Tilleson stated we need a timeline to reevaluate. Motion by Ligocki, second by Tilleson to go forward with a hybrid model as soon as the equipment is functional with an estimated timeframe of July 2021. Motion carried 7-0.
