Paul expanded on the funding options available to Greenspire including Dane County Affordable Housing Fund, FHLB Affordable Housing Program Grants and Low Income Housing Tax Credits. A LIHTC agreement would trigger a rental rate review and allow for additional financing and borrowing

options to assist with this project as well. Grants would also be pursued to meet the match requirement and the remaining amount would need to be borrowed for.
