- 3. Approval of meeting minutes 5-3-22: Motion to approve made by Todd McVey and seconded by John Basco. Minor correction: the start time was changed from 2:00 as printed to the correct start time of 1:00. Motion carried.
- 4. Review and discussion of May 24, 2022 Alcohol Age Compliance Checks. The results of the May 24 compliance checks were distributed and discussed. Pellett pointed out that research affirms that there is a real shift in underage drinking when compliance checks are done regularly and consistently. Currently, only passing licensees are identified in a newspaper ad (thanking them for their adherence to underage drinking laws). Motion by Jim Baldauf, Seconded by Chad O'Neil to recommend that both passing AND failing licensees be listed in newspaper advertisement after the fall checks. Licensees will be notified in advance of this change. Motion carried.
- 5. Other items/Future Business: For discussion and potential action in August: what other information should be added to compliance check pre-notification in the fall? What revisions do we want to recommend for next year's license renewal? (It was noted that Waunakee has an annual mandatory meeting/training for all licensees prior to renewal.)
