Minutes:

Monthly Reports:

Contract Renewal:

January 1st is the contract date. Broihahn Management recommended a one year contract with the management fee would staying the same. Committee discussed contract length, preferring that it be 2 years. Broihahn Management agreed to a two year contract stating that the management fee may increase in the second year.

Matson motioned to enter into a two year contract with Broihahn Management for the Greenspire apartments, second by McGlynn. Motion carried unanimously.

Preservation Revitalization Grant:

Thompson explained the process and reported her conversation with employee Rural Development was positive. Committee and Broihahn Group agreed that it would be worth the time of putting together the grant. Olson and Broihahn will start moving forward with process.
